Polar Express final cost is \$252.67. 104 kids participated. Cookies, milk, candy canes and presents were offered. The Board approved the overage from its previous commitment.

New:

Yoga participant makes and sells mittens for \$25, and has donated everything to the Friends, about \$300 to date.

We received a thank you note from Annis Dwan for the Friends' activities, and at the recent Cookbook Club meeting Annis encouraged four people to join the Friends.

The library will not offer the grow tower this winter. The second year would have had a much higher cost with an older model.

Rather than offer an activity with a charge to patrons, Cara and Joan will offer an upcycled book program on Saturday, February 1. There will be no cost to the library or patrons, and it gives us an opportunity to repurpose donated and withdrawn books.
